

# First class work at University of Wales, Cyncoed

Our recent project at the University of Wales Cyncoed campus involved work to improve drainage by inserting sand slits at 1.5 metre centres, korrowing-off, fraze mowing and re-seeding two rugby pitches.

Our expertise in this area has been in ever greater demand and, since improving the

drainage on an existing pitch is far less costly than replacing the pitch entirely, we see this trend continuing as budgets for schools and college recreation and sports facilities get squeezed even further by cuts in public expenditure in coming years.

One of the additional problems created by the poor drainage was that the dug outs

used to flood. Our solution was to excavate and then install a stone carpet and drainage with a shock pad and artificial carpet. The client is so happy with the result they would now like to create more dugouts.
